Family Child Care (FCC) is the care of children in affiliated homes, either privatized base housing or off-base homes.

The Family Child Care Program provides an alternative to center-based care for families that need evening care, weekend care, care for children with special needs, infants and school-age children and care during swing and midnight shifts.

ELIGIBILITY AND PARTICIPATION

Children ages 2 weeks through 12 years of any active duty member, reserve member during Primary UTA weekends and Annual Training, civilian employee or contractor employed at Moody AFB.

Child care is provided on an equal opportunity basis in all FCC homes. Children are required to have current and updated immunizations. Parents must sign a contract, which will be maintained by the provider. Children who have chronic health problems, including HIV-positive children, will not be discriminated against.

EXPANDED CHILD CARE (ECC)

The ECC program assists families with special circumstances concerning child care. ECC Programs include:

EXTENDED DUTY CARE (EDC) - Available during non-traditional hours for parents working temporarily extended or additional shifts to support the mission.

EMERGENCY MEDICAL CARE (EMC) -

Provides care for families who are experiencing an emergency medical issue with an immediate family member.

PRE-DEPLOYMENT CARE (PDCC) AND DEPLOYMENT CARE (DCC)

Provides child care for children 12 and under. Up to 16 hours of care per child is available to those deploying for more than 30 days. Must submit completed AF FCC ECC Form signed by sponsor's supervisor with a copy of orders 48 hours prior to care needed

RETURNING HOME CARE (RHC) - Child care for eligible members returning after a minimum 30-day deployment in support of a contingency operation, after a series of short-term deployments totaling 30 days in a six-month period, or during members' two-week R&R leave from deployed location.

ANG/AFR Home Community Care

(HCC) - Allows ANG/AFR parents to use licensed & affiliated EDC homes on drill weekends.

HOURS AND FEES

Each FCC provider determines his/her hours of operation. FCC also provides child care for volunteers and a subsidy program. Visit the FCC page at www.moodyfss.com for more information.

PERMANENT CHANGE OF STATION CARE (PCS CARE)

- Care for children while parents prepare for PCS move. Covers 20 hours of care per child at both departing and new base. Must be used within 60 days of departure or arrival. Contact the A&FRC at 257-3333 for more information.

HOW CAN I ENROLL MY CHILD IN FAMILY CHILD CARE?

Parents wishing to enroll their children in the FCC program can obtain the names of certified providers by contacting the FCC office (or at www.moodyfss.com). Parents are responsible for contacting and selecting their provider.

Parents must complete all registration forms (AF1181 and General Enrollment Form) with their provider of choice. Parents seeking subsidy support must schedule a time with the FCC Coordinator to have their fees evaluated, and must attach current LES and/or pay statements for both sponsor and spouse.
