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REGISTRATION PROCESS

Sponsor or spouse must show a valid DoD ID card. Please bring copies of your LES and/or pay stub and copies of your child's shot record. An emergency contact person, besides yourself or your spouse, must be designated on AF form 1181. All parents are required to attend an orientation with the school age coordinator.
