Moody Inn Guest Responsibilities

All guests are responsible for:

ANY DAMAGES TO THE ROOMS AND/OR FURNISHINGS. PLEASE DO NOT REMOVE ANY ITEMS FROM THE ROOM.

*NOTE: REARRANGEMENT OF ROOM FURNISHINGS IS NOT PERMITTED.

- 1. Ensuring room is kept neat and orderly.
- 2. Ensuring personal effects and property are not left on the bed. Housekeepers will not move or pick up your property at any time. Leaving items lying around could result in your room not being properly cleaned or your bed not being made.
- 3. Security of personal property. High value items should be locked in the safe located in your unit/room.
- 4. Keeping your room locked at all times, especially when you are not in the room.
- 5. Reporting maintenance problems to the front desk. *Note: A maintenance request form is provided in the guest room. Additional slips are located on the desk.*
- 6. Conduct of dependents/guests. Children under the age of 12 years old must have adult supervision at all times.
- 7. Be respectful of other guests' need for quiet and privacy.
- 8. Candles are not permitted in any rooms.
- 9. Overloading electrical circuits use of multiple plugs is unauthorized.
- 10. Conserve energy *flip the switch!*

*NOTE: PETS ARE ONLY PERMITTED IN DESIGNATED PET FRIENDLY QUARTERS. THEY MAY NOT BE TIED OUTSIDE NOR LOCKED IN YOUR VEHICLE.



Guest Responsibilities

- 1. **PETS** Are required to be housed in a designated unit only. If a pet is found in non-designated pet unit, guest will be charged actual costs to deep clean and lost revenue, until room is brought back to availability. Pet (s) will be removed from the room. Local kennel locations are available at the front desk.
- 2. **NO SMOKING** -If a guest is found smoking in the room or smoking outside the room where the room has a cigarette odor; they will be asked to check out immediately and will be charged up to a \$150 non-refundable restoration fee.
- 3. **ROOM CONDITION & CONTENTS** Guests are responsible for the condition of the room. Furniture should not be rearranged and items will not be removed from unit. If the room is found in unsatisfactory condition, an additional cleaning fee based on actual expenses to return the room to available inventory. During your stay in a TLF, it is the guests responsibility to maintain a clean kitchen and wash the dishes. A dishwasher is provided to clean dishes/cooking utensils, prior to check-out.
- 4. **CHILDREN** Guests are responsible for their children; Georgia Dept of Human Services guidance is as follows: Children 8 years of younger should not be left alone. Children between the ages of 9 and 12 (based on maturity level), may be left alone for a brief period of less than two hours. Children 13 years and older, (who are at an adequate level of maturity) may be left alone and may perform the role of babysitter, as authorized by the parent, for up to 12 hours.
- 5. **ROOM CLEANING** To have your unit serviced, please have your "*Do Not Disturb* (*DND*)" sign removed by 1 pm each day. For the safety and welfare of our guests, after a "*DND*" sign has been displayed for 72 hours, housekeeping is required to enter the room. Pet rooms must be entered daily. Ensure your pet is secure (kenneled) when departing your room.

Housekeeping Service will provide for:

- A. General and Stay over service (dusting, vacuuming, bathroom cleaning, clean towels, and emptying of trash receptacles) is provided seven days a week unless a "DND" sign is placed on the doorknob. Our policy is to change sheets every seven days and/or at checkout. If the sheets become soiled or by guest request in less than seven days, they will be changed.
 - B. Extended Stay: Same service as above, except bed linens are changed every 7 days.

CHECK-OUT TIME IS 11 AM— After 11 am, you may be charged an additional fee equivalent to the daily room rate.



Moody Inn Lodging Information

Amenities – Amenities are provided in the room. If you need additional amenities, they are available at the front desk.

Automated Teller Machines (ATMs) – ATMs are available at the following locations:

- Main Exchange
- AAFES Shopette
- Southeastern Credit Union

Automated Voice Mail Messages – Voice Mail is available in all rooms. For specific instructions, see the "Telephone Information" section.

Base Chapel – Moody's Chapel, located at 5120 Austin Ellipse (building 110). Please refer to the base newspaper for the most current listing of service times or call the chapel at 229-257-3211. Emergency contact number 229-257-3501.

Check Cashing – Check cashing is available at the Base Exchange (proper identification required). The Moody Inn can only accept checks for payment of room charges.

Check-In/Check-Out – Check-In time is 1400 hours. Check-Out time is 1100 hours. The late check-out charge is equivalent to the daily room rate.

Check-Out Items – We have the following items available for check out by registered guests at the front desk: *various board games and books*. You may check out these items as you need them, free of charge.

Classified Document Storage – Moody Inn is not authorized to store classified documents. Contact the Command Post at 257-3501 for classified document storage.

Conference Room – Located in building 201. Please check with the front desk for availability. *Check maps section of guest book*

Customer Comment Card – Our goal is to ensure you a pleasant stay. Please fill out the customer comment card in your room, ask for one at the front desk or respond to the electronic card (Must provide an email address during reservation process or at check in).

Jogging Route – see "Maps" section for jogging routes.

Do Not Disturb Signs – If you do not want housekeeping services in the morning, insert the "*Do Not Disturb*" sign into your room key slot located on the outside of your room. For the safety and welfare of our guests, after a "*DND*" sign has been on a guest room door for 72 hours, the housekeeping staff is required to enter the room. All other rooms will get service even if the "*DND*" sign is taken down before 1 pm. Pet rooms must be entered daily.

Emergency Shelter (Hurricane or Tornado Procedures) –

- 1. When notified by Lodging or the Security Police to vacate, please be prompt in doing so.
- 2. Take needed items such as pillows, blankets, food, formula and diapers for babies and prescription medication to the shelter.
- 3. Personnel without transportation will be notified of the time/location of transport to shelter.
- 4. Sponsors must make sure their dependents are evacuated to shelters or leave the local area.
- 5. When the "all clear" to return has been given, please return borrowed items from Lodging.

WARNING SIGNALS:

- ATTACK WARNING: Wavering or warbling tone on base sirens for 3 to 5 minutes. (ACTUAL ATTACK DETECTED) Seek overhead protection immediately.
- ATTENTION ALERT SIGNAL: A steady tone on base sirens 3 to 5 minutes. (DISASTER EMERGENCY). Turn your radio/TV to local stations for official instructions. Obey recommendations from local and base officials.

Express Check Out –Express Check-Out envelopes are available in DV suites.

Fax Service – Facsimile service is available for official business, free of charge, at the front desk. Our fax number is DSN 460-4971 or commercial (229) 257-4971.

Fire Alarm – Fire Alarm boxes are on the exterior walls of all buildings. In the event of a fire, activate the alarm system, then immediately notify the front desk.

Fire/Ground Safety – Please avoid the following hazards:

- Using unauthorized cooking or heating devices in your room
- Placing hot appliances on tables, drawers, or beds
- Overloading electrical circuits use of multiple plugs is unauthorized
- Leaving electrical appliances plugged in when you leave the room
- Leaving cooking equipment unattended
- Candles in rooms are NOT AUTHORIZED

Guest Business Center – Located in building 201. There are two computers and a printer available for guest use. Please see front desk for information. *Check maps section of guest book*

Ice Machines – Ice machines are located in the center portion of building 213 and 325. An ice machine can also be found in building 201. Please see the "maps" section for directions.

Laundry Rooms – Washers and dryers are provided in rooms of bldgs. 200, 215 and 217. In Bldg. 213-on the first and second floors, center of the building; Bldg. 325-on the first and second floors, center of building, and in Bldg. 201. Detergent is available for purchase at the front desk, as well as in vending machines located near the laundry rooms. See "maps" section for directions. NOTE: The vending machines are controlled by the Base Exchange.

Laundry/Dry Cleaning – The on-base laundry/dry cleaning services are in the BX mall. Call 253-0980 for hours of operation. Military clothing sales is also located in the BX (253-1754).

Linens/Towels – If guests need additional linens *or* towels, contact the front desk. Do not remove linens *or* towels from your room. All additional linens provided will be collected and inventoried for accountability purposes. Guests will be charged for linens not collected.

Fitness Center – Guests are invited to use the fitness center located in building 404. Please see "Maps" section for directions.

Lost & Found – Items left in the rooms at checkout time are turned in to the front desk. If you discover some articles are missing after you depart please call DSN 460-3893 or commercial (229) 257-3893. Lodging will attempt to contact guest. Items are discarded after 30 - 60 days.

Lost Keys – If you lose your room key please notify the front desk. **Mail** – If you plan to please visit the base post office for assistance. Use this address below:

Maintenance – If you encounter a maintenance problem, please notify the front desk or complete the In-Room Maintenance Slip (located on your desk).

Moving Trucks – Moving trucks or oversized vehicles may only be parked in the overflow parking lot located behind bldg 217. Contact Outdoor Rec at 257-3430 or the front desk for information about long-term parking.

Non-Smoking Rooms – All rooms at Moody Inn are "Non-Smoking" rooms. Guests found smoking in rooms will be charged up to a \$150 cleaning fee.

Parking- Please park in slots outside your room. Business Suites slots are assigned.

PCS Guests – In accordance with AFMAN34-135, 5.3, TLF reservations: The maximum TLF stay for Priority 1 guests (members arriving/departing PCS) is 30 days (if available). A signed memo from the first sergeant or commander must be submitted for an extension. A template is available at the front desk. Extensions are not automatic and are given on a case-by-case basis, if space is available.

Personal Effects/Property – Housekeepers are instructed not to pick up or move a guest's personal property at any time. **Leaving items lying around your room results in not receiving proper cleaning.** Your assistance in keeping your room orderly is greatly appreciated.

Pets – In order to maintain our high standards and quality of our lodging facilities, pets are only permitted in **designated pet friendly units** on a first-come, first-served basis.



Air Force Inns policy is to charge a standard fee of \$10.00 per night, regardless of the number of pets in the unit, for the duration of your stay. There is a maximum of two pets (dog or cat only) allowed, unless the amount or other type of pet is approved by the Lodging Manager. If any damage to Air Force property is caused by a pet (s), a fee may be assessed at the manager's discretion. Pet TLF's are equipped with the following: (if pet items are missing or damaged, your credit card will be charged (or a cash payment must be received, for the amount listed).

Pet / Kennel \$100.00
 Food / Water Bowl \$20.00

A list of local kennel facilities is available at the front desk, as requested. If a pet TLF is unavailable and other TLFs are available, you must reside on base. You must make other arrangements for your pet or the pet must be kenneled... A Non-Availability will not be issued if space is available. (AFMAN 34-135 3.18.7)

Please check map section for location of dog walk and doggie pot. Pets must be leashed when outside the room and supervised at all times.

Reservations – Reservations for Business Suites (O-6 & above and Chief Suite) are taken by the Wing Protocol Office, 257-4144. Reservations are accepted, Monday-Friday, 0730-1600 hours. After 1600, DV reservations (one night stay only) can be made by calling the front desk. For all other reservation requests, please contact our front desk. If assistance is required for group reservations please contact the Guest Services Manager at 257-3893 ext. 366.

Room Payments – Guests must secure their room with a credit card at check-in. Moody Inn accepts cash, checks (amount of charges only), VISA, Master Card, American Express, for payment on account. The BX provides check cashing privileges for authorized users. Space Available guests must pay for their rooms in advance, during check-in. All other guests on official orders, must pay room charges every 15 days.

WIRELESS HIGH SPEED INTERNET ACCESS (HSIA) INSTRUCTIONS


Wireless internet service is provided via an 802.11b/g signal. This signal is not encrypted, and no login credentials are needed. The Dynamic Host Configuration Protocol (DHCP) service will automatically setup your Internet Protocol (IP) and your Domain Name System (DNS). DNS is an Internet System that translates web names into IP addresses. If you have trouble connecting to the wireless service please see below.

PC Setup Instructions

- 1. Turn on your computer; most computers will try to automatically connect to any available wireless network. Connect to the Service Set ID (SSID) Network Name: midatlanticbb. If you cannot connect or unable to see the signal see troubleshooting below.
- 2. Ensure your computer is setup to use the DHCP service or obtain an IP automatically. If you regularly connect to wireless hot spots your computer should be setup for this. If unsure please see troubleshooting section below.
- 3. If you're having a problem connecting to a Virtual Private Network (VPN) please contact our help desk.

Troubleshooting

1. Unable to detect wireless signal – If you are unable to see the "midatlanticbb" wireless signal. Verify that your wireless card is on. Some laptops have switches that will turn the wireless card on or off. If you're unable to see the wireless signal, try moving your laptop to another part of the room to check if it's a signal issue. Contact the Help Desk for support on wireless signal issues.

From the same box Click the General tab- Properties button, in the window that opens, scroll
until you see "Internet Protocol TCP/IP" and double click it. Ensure the following settings
are correct and click okay to exit all windows. You may need to reboot.

Microsoft Windows 7/Vista based machines ip settings can be configured by doing the following commands:

Click Start-Control Panel-Network and Internet-Network and Sharing Center-Manage Network Connections or Change Adapter Settings-Right Click Wireless Network Connection and click status, if you are unable to click status Click Properties.

If you've clicked status, then click the details button and note the IPv4 settings. If the IPv4 settings do not match the IP settings in paragraph 3 or you clicked properties scroll until you see "Internet Protocol Version 4" and double click it. Ensure the following are correct and click okay to exit all windows.

Obtain IP address automatically is checked

Obtain DNS server address automatically is checked.

Apple OSX 10 based machines IP settings can be configured by doing the following commands, Click Apple Menu-System Preferences-Network-Under show select the Air Port Adapter or Wireless adapter

Click the TCP/IP tab and note the Ipv4 settings. Ensure **Using DHCP** is selected under "Configured Ipv4."

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


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


Base Map

FACT SHEET

23RD WING

The mission of the 23rd Wing is to organize, train and equip Flying Tigers to rapidly deploy and execute the Global Precision Attack (GPA), Personnel Recovery (PR), and Agile Combat Support (ACS) Service Core Functions to meet worldwide Combatant Commander requirements.

The wing executes worldwide close air support, force protection and peacetime and personnel recovery operations in support of humanitarian and U.S. national security interests, and in support of contingency operations across the globe.

The 23rd Wing aircraft include the A-10C, HH-60G, HC-130P and HC-130J.

The A-10C Thunderbolt II is the first Air Force aircraft specially designed for close air support of ground forces and has been digitally upgraded with the latest precision-guided weaponry and communications.

The HH-60G Pave Hawk helicopter provides rescue forces to include a combat search and rescue and personnel recovery platform for the Air Force through its ability to operate in a vast array of rescue scenarios in any weather condition.

The HC-130P Combat King flies low-level missions into hostile territory to conduct rescues and to provide air refueling for our rescue helicopters' security interests.

The HC-130J Combat King II is mission ready to rapidly deploy to execute combatant commander directed recovery operations to include airdrop, air land, helicopter air-to-air refueling, and forward are ground refueling missions.

The wing executes worldwide peacetime, combat search and rescue operations and personnel recovery missions in support of humanitarian and U.S. national security interests, and in support of the global war on terrorism.

Command & Control Flight

The Command Post functions as the executive agency for the Wing Commander and is authorized to communicate command direction to all organizations that support the installation. The Command Post is the single agency on base responsible for the execution of command and control activities. These activities include various tasks and requirements established by higher directives, plans, and also any Commander directed activities.

History Office

The 23rd Wing History Office performs and manages historical activities, programs, and functions. The office provides historical research and reference services, performs research, interview personnel, and prepares analytical historical publications. It also assembles and maintains historical document repositories for reference and research.

Manpower and Organization Office

Provide manpower management support to Headquarters 23rd Wing and all associate units at Moody Air Force Base. Advise commanders and agency chiefs on best organization, use, and mix of manpower resources during peacetime and wartime. Implement Headquarters United States Air Force and Headquarters Air Combat Command manpower programs and administers the Air Force Productivity Program. Lead OMB Circular A-76 studies for 23rd Wing units.

Public Affairs Office

Expanding awareness and support for the world's most respected aerospace force. The U.S. Air Force engages in Public Affairs to provide trusted counsel to leaders; build, maintain, and strengthen Airman Morale and readiness; enhance public trust and support; and achieve global influence and deterrence.

To do so, Public Affairs Operations facilitate the following programs:

- Internal Information: Ensures a free flow of information to Air Force personnel and their families, through our official public website. Internal information achieves informed internal support for the Air Force mission. PA also responds to inquiries by Air Force members and their families.
- Media Relations: Ensures a free flow of information through the news media to the general public and achieves informed public support for the Air Force mission. Public Affairs responds to inquiries by the news media and brings Air Force issues to the public agenda.



- Community Relations: Creates mutual acceptance, respect, appreciation and cooperation between the Air Force and the community. This helps maintain two-way communication between Air Force people and the communities in which they live. Public Affairs programs also assist Air Force recruiting efforts, and respond to requests for Air Force participation in public events. PA additionally manages environmental Public Affairs issues, promotes coordination, cooperation and mutual understanding among DOD components and ensures legal mandates of community involvement are met.

Office of the Staff Judge Advocate

The Staff Judge Advocate is the primary legal advisor to the 23rd Wing and 93rd Air Ground Operations Wing and oversees Base Legal Office operations. The legal office staff provides legal support essential for military operations. They litigate to preserve command prerogatives, administer military justice and civil law programs and educate and counsel on the law. They also provide legal assistance to active duty members, their dependents and the retiree community.

Equal Opportunity

The Equal Opportunity office provides various human resource services such as equal opportunity assistance information, alternate dispute resolution (ADR) and helping agency referrals. They also provide informal and formal complaint assistance and processing to all federal employed civilians as well as military members, their family members and retirees who believe they have experienced unlawful discrimination on the basis of race, color, national origin, religion, and sex, to include sexual harassment.

Equal Opportunity incidents are processed by the office and has strict U.S. Air Force, Headquarters reporting guidelines. The EO staff provides technical guidance as subject matter experts for higher-level complaint processing. They conduct Unit Climate Assessments (UCA) for commanders at all levels and semi-annual Wing Climate Assessments for the installation commander. Periodic "out and about" visits are also used to assess organizational and wing equal opportunity and treatment climates. Additionally, classes are provided to all military and civilian personnel in various human relations' subject matter.

Office of the Inspector General

Acts as the 'eyes and ears' of the wing commander. The IG addresses the concerns of Air Force active duty, Reserve and Guard members, civilian employees, family members, retirees and the best interests of the Air Force.

They operate by advocating fair, impartial treatment, improving the quality of life through detection and elimination of all forms of fraud, waste and abuse. The office evaluates the wing's processes, makes suggestions for improvement and increases trust and confidence in leadership and the Air Force. The IG allows commanders to proactively seek opportunities for improvement through behavior and process modification by providing trend analysis and heightening awareness of issues.

Their ultimate goal is to sustain a credible Inspector General Complaints Program.

Wing Plans, Programs and Inspections



The primary function of the 23rd Wing Plans, Programs and Inspection office is to provide cross-wing coordination on all current and future operations for Moody and three geographically-separated units.

Wing plans monitors, coordinates and manages all wing-wide long range plans, and base support plans in addition to managing the Commander's Support Staff during contingency or disaster response.

Wing programs manages all higher headquarters program changes, congressionally-mandated programs and treaty compliance.

Wing inspections is responsible for providing the commander with an accurate assessment of combat readiness for more than 5,500 personnel and \$1.5 billion in assets.

Wing scheduling manages aviation tasking's and event requests, individual aviation tasking and tracks and coordinates the wing flying hour program. Force support provides operational information technology expertise to subordinate units with Mission Information Manager Personnel both at home station and for ongoing deployed operations.

Safety Office

The 23rd Wing Safety office provides development, coordination and management of mishap prevention for Moody. Potential mishaps are reduced though the use and analysis of current accident/injury data, hazard abatement plans, periodic inspections and surveys of all command and tenant facilities and activities. Safety personnel investigate accidents and make recommendations to foresee and prevent mishap recurrence. In coordination with the 23rd Wing Safety council, this office develops standards, policies, and procedures for mission unique safety activities through the use of Operational Risk Management (ORM).
