## LET US HELP YOU!

---

The Moody AFB School Liaison Office (SLO) is your first stop for educational information for grades PK - 12. The SLO is available to assist with a variety of resources and questions.

### TRADITIONAL PUBLIC SCHOOLS

Your physical residence determines the public school district and school zone for your student. There are limited options on "school choice". Medical records are required to be transferred to the *Georgia Department of Public Health Forms 3300* (Ear, Eye, Dental, Nutrition) and 3231 (Immunizations); all are available through the Moody AFB Med Clinic.

### ATTENDANCE

Attendance is strictly enforced. If contacted by school officials about an absence, respond immediately. ALL absences (e.g. excused, unexcused and *GA Military Family Act* dates) are counted IAW GA Education Rule 160-5-1-10 and local truancy protocols.

### DEPLOYMENTS

Are you being deployed into a war zone? Would you like to spend some quality time as a family before or after the separation? Contact the SLO about process the *GA Military Family Act* request letter. This allows for up to five days per school year, but the letter must be completed and approved by the district superintendent in advance of the planned absence.

### REMOTE TOURS

Is your loved one serving a remote tour in a combat zone? If he/she is coming home on mid-tour, this may be covered under the *GA Military Family Act*.
