NAF (Food Funds)

Pays for the edible items only. Cannot be used for alcohol, plates, charcoal, lighter fluid, plasticware, etc.

UNITE funds are not to be used for the following:

Squadron holiday parties, end of year events, balls, banquets, eating events, dining in/out, combat dining in/out, squadron training/meetings, change of commands, promotions/retirements, children/spouse only events or base-wide special events. (Squadron holiday, Christmas, Hanukkah and end of year celebrations are typically subsidized by squadron booster club funding.) UNITE events MUST be inclusive to all Airmen in a squadron and cannot be divided based on rank, pay grade, age, race, gender or religion. Please call for more information regarding other prohibited uses.

What is UNITE?

UNITE is a recreational based program that focuses on “Revitalizing Squadrons.” Unit Commanders are in the best position to execute resources that benefit Airmen under their authority. This initiative provides Commanders with the funding to initiate programs that help their squadron. UNITE funds are allocated based on squadron manning.

What can UNITE funds be used for?

UNITE funding can be used for activities and food. The activities must be team building in nature and the food must be offered in conjunction with the activity. Funds cannot be used for holiday parties.

How do I begin?

Get in touch with your UNITE POC. POC's can be a First Shirt, Chief or other trained POC appointed by your squadron Commander. All POC's must get approval from their leadership before requesting UNITE funds. Funding is based on the calendar year, NOT fiscal year, and MUST be allocated by November 1, 2023. Approval may take up to 10 days.
