# ENROLLMENT

---

## ENROLLMENT POLICY

In order to enroll in the program, children must be between the ages of 5 - 12 years old. Children the age of five must be attending Kindergarten prior to entering the School Age Program for school year enrollment.

## REGISTRATION PROCESS

All parents begin by registering on [MilitaryChildcare.com](http://MilitaryChildcare.com). Once offered a spot, parents will be contacted to begin registration through CYPBMS and notified of their orientation date. A sponsor or spouse must show a valid DoD ID card, bring a copy of a current LES or pay stub and a copy of the child's immunization records. Please bring any special needs documents if applicable. An emergency contact, other than yourself or spouse, must be designated on the CYPBMS parent portal. All parents or guardians are required to attend an orientation with the School Age Coordinator.
