YOUTH SPORTS & FITNESS PROGRAM

The Moody AFB Youth Center offers Spring Soccer, Fall Soccer and Winter Basketball. We also offer a variety of specialty camps throughout the year to include Summer Soccer Camps. Payment is required at the time of registration. All patrons are required to have a sports physical prior to registration. START SMART

A developmentally appropriate introductory sports program for children three to five years of age. Start Smart helps parents in preparing their children for organized sports leagues in a fun and non-threatening environment. Sports include soccer and basketball.

Moody AFB is proud to be a member of the National Alliance of Youth Sports (NAYS). All of our coaches are trained and certified members of the National Sports Coaches Association (NYSCA). INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAMS

Seasonal instructional classes are offered during the school year, including dance (ballet, tap and jazz). Several week-long summer instructional camps are also offered. A sports physical is required.

PROJECT LEARN

Project Learn helps youth ages 9 - 18 achieve academic success by providing homework help, tutoring and high-yield learning activities that encourage youth to become self-directed learners.

CLUBS

PRETEEN PROGRAM CLUBS

Torch Club: A small-group youth leadership and service club for members ages 11 - 13 years of age (Jr Torch is offered for youth age 10).

Fine Arts Club: Youth ages 9 - 18 meet once a week to experience a variety of artistic media such as art, music and drama.

Cooking Club: Youth learn everything from proper food preparation to making delicious snacks and meals using the Food Guide Pyramid.

TEEN PROGRAM CLUBS

AF Teen Council: A leadership club for teens between the ages of 13 - 18, to make positive changes in the teen and military community on a large scale.

Keystone: A youth advisory program that encompasses community service, leadership and social development offered to youth 14 - 18 years of age.

JR Staff: An opportunity for YP youth ages 13 - 18 to mentor other youth and engage in leadership roles and civic engagement.
