CLASS RULES

ARRIVE BEFORE CLASS STARTS

Please arrive before class starts. Once Mrs. Devon invites your child into class, please remind them to sit on a colored spot. They will receive assigned spots once recital choreography begins.

KEEP TALKING AT A MINIMUM

Please remind your child to listen as they learn the secrets of dance and performing arts. If they have a question, please remind them to raise their hand to ask.

NO FOOD

Please no food or gum. All water must be in a no-spill water bottle.

SCHEDULED BREAKS

Your child will receive a water break in the middle of class. Please encourage them to use the facilities prior to class starting.

WEAR THE PROPER ATTIRE

Please ensure that your child's hair is pulled back and is wearing the proper attire to class. All belongings **MUST** be marked with the student's name. Proper dance attire is as follows:

- Pink ballet shoes
- Nude tap shoes
- Nude jazz shoes
- Dance tights (any color)
- Dance leotard (any color)

Performing in front of an audience is a major part of a performer's education. It is a time when they can show off all the wonderful moves they have learned throughout the semester. Recitals give the chance for each student to take those steps out of the classroom and into the spotlight.

FEES

Costume and Performance Fee: \$65
